Funding

This license application must be received by the OBA office no later than **35 days** before the planned event. The application, completed in full, must be accompanied by the non-refundable license fee of \$100.00 & the officials' set expense fee of \$250.00. The total remittance will be \$350.00. Any parking expense for the officials will be reimbursed by the host, in cash & at the end of the event. Accepted: club checks; money order; cash Checks will be dated the current date & not post-dated. If the funds are not received, the date for the event will be given to another club & the applicant will lose their \$100.00 license fee. If the event is cancelled by the club/host, then the deposit of \$100.00 will be forfeited by the club/host. The refund of the officials' expense will be refunded. All expenses are the sole responsibility of the host including any alcohol, licensing & security.

Ring Personnel including Card Persons; Trophy Presenters; Reporters; Camera or Video Persons

The host will ensure that a Ring Steward (Security Person) will be at ring side through-out the show, with the primary duty to keep all persons a minimum of 6 feet from all official tables. No seats or other persons are permitted at the perimeter of the ring - which is within 6 feet of the ring. The host will provide the officials with water during the event. Permitted at ring side are officials that are participating in that event & also the announcer, the timekeeper & the doctor who will be seated near the timekeeper. There will be 4 tables at ringside - 3 small & 2 banquet tables at the official's side. The host must present either trophies or medals to the participants. Only certificates are not permitted. Any video or camera persons or reporters will deal directly with the Chief Official who may or may not permit them at ring side. If using any ring personnel i.e. card carriers or glove retrievers, they will be seated at the same distance away from the ring as the spectators & for the card carriers, the club will assign one adult to assist the ring personnel in & out of the ring & down the stairs.

Minors

No person that is not participating in the boxing event, & who is under the age of 18 years is permitted inside the ring.
 Any trophy presenter will be of a minimum 18 years of age & will be appropriately dressed for social acceptance as per the Chief Official's acceptance.

Coaches

All primary coaches (those that will work at ring top) will be fully certified minimum Level A.
 All secondary coaches (those that may have their Level A or who are working on their Levels) may assist in the Secondary position only.
 Coaches working OBA corners must be registered as 'Coach' with the OBA or its affiliated bodies.

Equipment

There will be 3 to 4 sets of 10 oz. gloves equal red to blue & 1 set of 16 oz. sparring gloves with 2 sparring head gears (lugs aka cheek protectors)
 The Glover will be over 18 years of age & be responsible for the cleaning & maintaining of the gloves & the enforcement of dress & wraps.

The Code of Conduct will be enforced.

Program - Twenty four (24) hours submitting

Twenty four (24) hours prior to the weigh-ins, the host will send to the OBA office, by FAX or Email, a list of the participating boxers & that form will be available through 'form downloads' on the internet under match-making. The form will be completed providing the boxer's names, club, date of birth & actual numerical total bouts including exhibitions as a color corner with their opponent listed on the opposite color. Home town should be RED. Do not write 'Novice' or 'Open'. Put the average weight in lbs, in the middle column separating the boxer's information. Boxer's weights will be filled in at the site during weigh-in & by the Chief Official or his delegate.
